Treasurer's Report: A financial Report was presented with the ending balances in the townships various

funds as of August 31, 2022. General Fund \$1,874,635.25, Police Fund \$361,024.27, Fire Fund \$547,321.57, T&A \$7,500.00, Current Tax \$266,511.64.

Elected Official/Department Head Updates:

Fire Department Report: Fire Chief Mark Hagemeister presented the Fire Report for August. There were 14 Medical First Responder calls and 11 Fire calls for the month, 7 of which were storm related.

Police Department Report: The police report for the month of August reported the following,

- Officers responded to a total of 346 calls for service for the month of August.
- Officers conducted a total of 104 traffic stops. Of those traffic stops, 23 citations were issued for traffic violations, 5 traffic crash reports were handled by officers. Of those crashes, 2 were personal injury accidents and there were 4 arrests for operating while intoxicated.
- Officers continue to be active enforcing traffic violations.
- Calls for service have been steady. Property crimes are low.
- On August 17 & 18 Sgt. Chesnutt and Chief Peters provided in service ALICE training to the Dryden Schools staff.

Installation of Bricks at Memorial park: Motion made by Diefenbach, seconded by Lowney to contract with American Tree to remove and install memorial bricks at the Memorial Park for \$500. Roll call vote: 5 Ayes, 0 Nays.
